The Gwen harkens back to Chicago's Magnificent Mile in the 1920s but remains firmly rooted in the twenty-first century. An homage to the Art Deco period in both architecture and ethos, The Gwen emblemizes this golden era while bringing iconic grandeur to today's worldly travelers.

This unmistakable union of history and modernity is embodied by our façade, famously created in 1928 by pioneer American sculptor Gwen Lux. Having produced artwork for Radio City Music Hall in New York City and General Motors Technical Center in Detroit, Lux made her mark as a rare female artist working in the male-dominated world of architectural design. Reminiscent of pencil drawings etched in stone, Lux's façade graced the renowned McGraw-Hill Building until the late 1990s, when the Chicago landmark was demolished and rebuilt as a hotel. Lux's bas-reliefs were disassembled piece by piece and preserved in a warehouse until they could be painstakingly reattached to the new construction, and the panels survive today as the indelible face of the hotel that bears their creator's name.

On September 1, 2015, The Gwen became an official member of Starwood Hotels & Resorts' Luxury Collection. 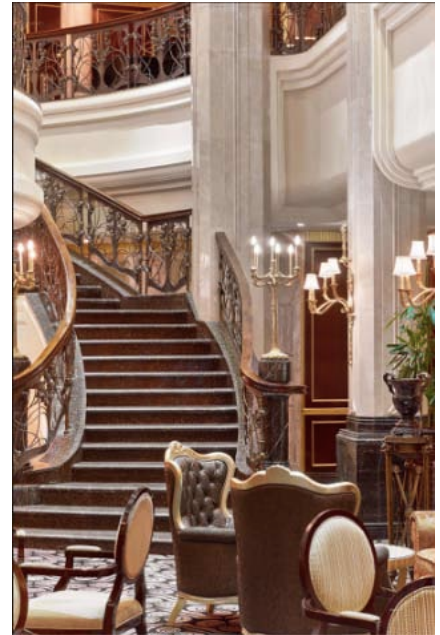
Originally constructed in the 1870s, The St. Regis Moscow Nikolskaya is a complex of historical buildings with an unrivaled location at the corner of Nikolskaya Street, Lubyanka Square, Maly Cherkassky Lane, and Bolshoi Lane. As the storied site of grand residences, a bookstore, and a chocolate boutique, Nikolskaya Street 12 boasts a rich cultural heritage.

From the first half of the eighteenth century until 1869, ornate mansions dotted the site where our hotel now stands. After being demolished in 1869, these buildings were eventually replaced in 1877–1879 by a complex of exquisite apartments designed by renowned architect Robert Gedike for Count Alexey Orlov-Davydov. Heir to a noble family, Count Orlov-Davydov served as master of ceremonies at the court of Romanov emperor Alexander II and deputy (MP) of the Fourth State Duma, a legislative assembly of the late Russian Empire.

The count rented his Moscow apartments to several illustrious tenants. These included the celebrated publisher Ivan Dmitrievich Sytin, who opened a bookstore on the premises, and Roman R. Koeller, who converted his suites into a prominent perfumery and a chocolate boutique.

In 1907, Koeller brought in revered French architect Édouard-Jean Niermans to design splendid art nouveau mosaics throughout his boutiques. Niermans's works had included theaters, hotels, casinos, restaurants, and concert halls in Paris and the Cote d'Azur—along with the world-famous Moulin Rouge. In collaboration with French master glassmaker Carlo Pizzagalli, Niermans embellished Koeller's shop windows and archways with rich floral designs, including beautiful irises, lilies, poppies, bluebells, and primroses. Part of these magnificent mosaics are still on display today, meticulously preserved as part of the distinguished legacy of the building.

The historic façade and space of the ground floor of the former Koeller boutiques were also retained during a painstaking six-year reconstruction that began in 2007. This eclectic architectural ensemble was converted into a hotel in 2013, and on October 3, 2014, it joined Starwood Hotels & Resorts' Luxury Collection.

Vancouver is also a haven for outdoor recreation. Historic Stanley Park is a 405-hectare public park framed by the waters of Vancouver Harbour and English Bay. Family-friendly attractions include horse-drawn carriage rides, a miniature train, and the Vancouver Aquarium, which boasts over 60,000 animals and the rainforest fauna of the Graham Amazon Gallery. At an elevation of 553 feet, Vancouver Lookout at Harbour Centre affords unforgettable views of the city. A glass elevator whisks you up to the observation deck, where expert guides lead hourly tours. Meanwhile, just 15 minutes from downtown Vancouver, Grouse Mountain's Skyride transports guests to a mountaintop playground for summer activities such as a zip-line course, hiking, a grizzly-bear habitat, a birds-of-prey exhibit, and a lumberjack show while winter activities include skiing, snowboarding, and ice-skating.

Vancouver is home to an energizing array of sports and cultural institutions. BC Place Stadium—the largest multipurpose venue in the province—is home to the BC Sports Hall of Fame while Rogers Arena hosts the Vancouver Canucks. The Vancouver Art Gallery houses the world's largest collection of works by renowned Canadian artist Emily Carr. Also within blocks are the Queen Elizabeth Theatre—headquarters of the Vancouver Opera and Ballet BC—and The Orpheum, a National Heritage Site that is also home to the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra and the Vancouver Bach Choir.

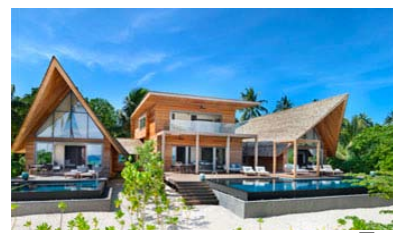
